### **The Gathering: This Saturday May 19, 2018 7 PM, Life Center**

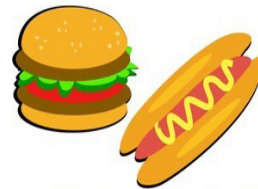
